## **What We Did:**

Our story today is about somebody who had a lot of power. We'll talk about what a centurion was and make a centurion craft. There are things that even the most powerful person on earth doesn't have control over; the centurion knew he didn't have power over sickness, but he had faith that Jesus did. Jesus is stronger and more powerful than any sickness and even stronger than death!

## **Suggestions for family devotions**

- ◇ **Sunday:** Read Luke 7:1-10. What amazed Jesus about the centurion?
- ◇ **Monday:** Read Hebrews 11:1-13. Share an example of a time you (or someone you know) did something with faith.
- ◇ **Tuesday:** Read Mark 11:22-24. What does Mark say can happen if someone believes?
- ◇ **Wednesday:** Read Philippians 4:11-13. Who did Paul (and who can we) depend on to provide for whatever we need?
- ◇ **Thursday:** Read Luke 1:35-37. Is there anything that is too hard for God to do?
- ◇ **Friday:** Read Romans 10:9-13. What does God give to those who believe?
- ◇ **Saturday:** Read Galatians 2:15-16. Are we made right by God through doing good things? What makes us right with God?
